Please keep your child home if s/he is showing any of these symptoms. Seek medical care and COVID-19 testing, if needed. Signs of illness can include but are not limited to:

- Fever of 100.4
- Loss of taste and smell
- Severe headache
- Flushed cheeks
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing Rash
- Congestion or runny nose
- New or worsening cough
- Diarrhea, nausea or vomiting

If a child has a fever, that child must be fever free without medication for 72 hours before returning to school. Medical excuses will be required for seasonal allergies. Together, we can keep our school healthy!
